 - c. Making the child feel unwanted,
 - d. Making the child feel unworthy of love,
 - e. Favoring other children.
4. If within the past three years there have been allegations of any verbal abuse of the child by you, please describe any such verbal abuse in detail indicating the applicability of any of the following:
 - a. Telling the child that such child is stupid,
 - b. Telling the child that such child is worthless,
 - c. Telling the child that such child is a loser,
 - d. Telling the child that such child ruined the child's parents life,
 - e. Telling the child that such child can do nothing right or clever,
 - f. Telling the child that such child is ugly and/or fat.

8. Within the past three years have you been arrested for any abuse of the child?
9. If your answer to the preceding interrogatory is in the affirmative, please state the following:
- a. All charges alleged in connection with any such arrest,
 - b. A description of any prior arrest, giving date and allegations,
 - c. The name of any arresting officer,
 - d. The name of any court where the case was arraigned,
 - e. Your current arrest status,
 - f. Whether you are now in jail pending trial, or out of jail pending trial,
 - g. The result and outcome of any such arrest.
10. If within the past three years you have been arrested for any abuse of the child, please describe the result and outcome of any allegation of child abuse against you, including the following:
- a. Whether the charges were ultimately dropped,
 - b. Whether you were convicted, describing the charges of which you were convicted,
 - c. The name of any court convicting you,
 - d. The date of any such conviction,
 - e. The length of any sentence served or fine paid,
 - f. The extent of any rehabilitation program ordered,
 - g. A description of any such rehabilitation program, including the name and address.
11. Within the past three years have you attended any voluntary parental support groups or program for parents who abuse children?
12. If your answer to the preceding interrogatory is in the affirmative, please state:
- a. A description of any such program,
 - b. The inclusive dates of your attendance at any such program,
 - c. The name and address of any such program,
 - d. Whether any such program was successfully completed by you,
 - e. Results and outcome of any such attendance,
 - f. Any continuing participation in the program.
13. If within the past three years you have voluntarily attended any parental support group for parents who abuse children, please describe each reason for your attending any such program, including the following:
- a. Any family pressure and encouragement,
 - b. Warning from social service agency,

Allegations of Child Neglect.

3. If within the past three years there has been any allegation of neglect of any child brought against you by any governmental agency, please state as to each type of child neglect alleged, including the following:
 - a. Insufficient and improper diet,
 - b. Insufficient sleep,
 - c. Child not bathed regularly,
 - d. Child's diapers not changed regularly,
 - e. Child's clothes not washed regularly,
 - f. Insufficient and inappropriate clothing,
 - g. Any child left unattended,
 - h. Any child's health problems ignored.
4. Within the past three years, has there been any investigation of you by any governmental agency alleging any neglect of any child?
5. If your answer to the preceding interrogatory is in the affirmative, please describe any such investigation in detail, including the following:
 - a. The name of any governmental agency investigating any such allegation of neglect,
 - b. A description of each previous investigation of you for any such child neglect,
 - c. The name and address of the caseworker or other person in charge of any such investigation,
 - d. The result and outcome of any such investigation.
6. If within the past three years there has been any investigation of you by any government agency for any child neglect, please describe the result or outcome of any such investigation, including the following:
 - a. No problem found and case closed,
 - b. Investigation ongoing,
 - c. You are currently subject to ongoing caseworker supervision,
 - d. Any such child has been removed from your home and placed in foster care or with other family members.

7. Within the past three years, have you been arrested for any neglect of any child?
8. If your answer to the preceding interrogatory is in the affirmative, please state:
 - a. Each charge on which you were arrested,
 - b. A description of each previous arrest, stating the date,
 - c. The name of each arresting officer,
 - d. The name of each court where you were arraigned,
 - e. The current status of your arrest, indicating whether in or out of jail,
 - f. The result and outcome of any such arrest, indicating whether the charges were dropped or you were convicted.
9. If within the past three years you have been convicted of any neglect of any child, please state:
 - a. Each charge that you were convicted of,
 - b. The name and address of the convicting court,
 - c. The date of each conviction,
 - d. A description of the sentence served or any fine paid,
 - e. A description of any rehabilitation program ordered, indicating the name and address of such program and the results of your attendance at any such program.
