**ORDER FIXING DATE OF PRELIMINARY
HEARING**

THIS MATTER having been opened to the Court by Curtis J. Romanowski, Esq., for *Romanowski Law Offices*, attorney for the Petitioners, Rhonda P. Webber and Ronald Webber, husband and wife, upon a Complaint for Adoption in the above matter by said Petitioners, Rhonda P. Webber and Ronald Webber, his wife, applying for the adoption of a child, in accordance with the provisions of the Statute; and it appearing that said child is under the custody and control of Rhonda P. Webber and Ronald Webber, having received the child with the consent of the Birth Mother and the Birth father, said Consents being annexed to said Complaint; and it is

FURTHER APPEARING from the Consents and Affidavits executed by the Birth Mother of the infant child that she has consented to said adoption and the consent to adoption and relinquishments were signed knowingly, voluntarily and intelligently; and it is

FURTHER APPEARING from the Consents and Affidavits executed by the Birth Father of the infant child that he has consented to said adoption and the consent to adoption and relinquishments were signed knowingly, voluntarily and intelligently;

THEREFORE, IT IS ON THIS ___ day of _____, 20__;

ORDERED that the preliminary hearing in the above matter be set down for the ___ day of _____, 20__ at ___ o'clock in the _____ noon or as soon thereafter as the matter be heard, before the Judge then sitting in the Family Part of the Superior Court, Chancery Division for Middlesex County, at the Courthouse, New Brunswick, New Jersey; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that Michael McGinty, the child sought to be adopted, is hereby declared to be a ward of this Court; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that (**Home Study Agency**) shall conduct an agency investigation and submit a written report required by **N.J.S.A. 9:3-48** to the Court _____ days prior to the Final Hearing; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Order be mailed to the said agency by the Clerk of the Court, together with a copy of Petitioner's Complaint within five (5) days of the date hereof; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that notice of the preliminary hearing shall be served upon the Birth Mother and the Birth Father of the child sought to be adopted by regular and certified mail or personal service at least (35) days prior to the return date. A Final Judgment of Adoption may be entered at the completion of the preliminary hearing.
